Welcome!

Neighborcare Health at Vashon Island High School is a full service health clinic that provides medical, dental and mental health services for students of Vashon Island High School, McMurray Middle School, and Chautauqua Elementary School among other students on the island. Funding for the Health Center is partially supported by the King County Best Starts for Kids Levy. Neighborcare Health staff members partner with the school nurse at the Health Center to provide high quality coordinated care to students.



Where?

Neighborcare Health at Vashon Island High School is located in the main school administration office during the construction of the permanent Health Center.

Why?

Our goal is to **help students do better in school** by working with them to **solve medical, dental and mental health concerns**. Our care team focuses on **promoting healthy lifestyles and preventing serious illness**.

Our Health Center is part of **Neighborcare Health**, a network of medical, dental, and school-based clinics, serving more than 70,000 patients in Seattle and Vashon Island each year. Neighborcare Health is committed to creating a health care home, that includes medical, dental and mental health care, and encourages long-term relationships between patients and providers.



When?

Neighborcare Health at Vashon Island High School provides services to all students on weekdays before, during and after school hours. **To schedule an appointment please call or stop by the office.** The Health Center is closed during school holidays and summer break.

When Neighborcare Health at Vashon Island High School is closed, students and their families are encouraged to call a Neighborcare Health clinic for medical, dental and mental health services. The closest clinics to Vashon Island High School are **Neighborcare Health at Vashon** for medical services, 206-463-3671, and **Neighborcare Health at High Point**, for medical and dental services, 206-461-6950.

Students and their families are also welcome at any of our non-school-based clinics in Seattle (see back cover).



At Neighborcare Health, we believe that everyone deserves a health care home, regardless of income or insurance status. A health care home is where a team of medical, dental and mental health professionals works in collaboration with each patient to develop a personal health improvement plan. It's a place where we encourage long-term relationships with patients and care for them from birth through end of life. No matter which Neighborcare Health clinic patients visit, we want them to feel at home.



What services are offered to students?

Medical and mental health services offered at Vashon Island High School include:

- Evaluation and treatment of common health problems
 - Sports physicals
 - Preventive health care
 - Reproductive health
 - Vaccinations
 - Individual, family and group mental health counseling
 - Family coordination to establish health care home
 - Insurance eligibility and enrollment assistance
 - Crisis intervention
 - Community and school-based referrals
 - Health promotion and health education
- A part-time mental health therapist will provide mental health services on-site at Chautauqua Elementary School to serve elementary and middle school students.

Dental services are provided to students at Vashon Island High School, Chautauqua Elementary and McMurray Middle School on a rotating schedule. All procedures are performed by one of our licensed dentists and dental assistants using portable equipment to provide high quality, convenient care at school.

Dental services include:

- Oral exams
- Cleanings
- X-rays
- Sealants
- Fluoride Treatment
- Fillings
- Some extractions



Any procedure that cannot be completed at school can be scheduled at one of our Neighborcare Health dental clinics located throughout Seattle (see back panel).

How can students use the center?

Register! Students must register with Neighborcare Health at Vashon Island High School in order to receive care. A complete registration form and consent with parent or guardian signature is all that is needed to access all of the services offered. **Students 18 years old and over can sign registration forms themselves. Under Washington state law, students under 18 can register themselves for confidential care, including reproductive health services and mental health counseling.**

Request to Report slips are given for appointments during school. We will do everything possible to schedule or reschedule so students miss as little class as possible. Students may also visit the clinic without an appointment by getting a pass from their teacher or a referral from the school nurse.

What is the cost?

Our intention is to reduce as many barriers as possible to accessing medical, dental and mental health services. **No student will be denied services due to inability to pay.** Because the Best Starts for Kids Levy covers only a portion of the costs to operate the Health Center, we bill insurance companies when possible.

We have Eligibility Specialists who work in all of our sites to assist families and students to enroll in health insurance programs. We accept a wide variety of health insurance plans, including Washington Apple Health (Medicaid) and bill them directly for services. Lab services for non-confidential services are billed to the student's health insurance by LabCorp.

Nurse Practitioner

The Nurse Practitioner is a licensed medical provider who provides comprehensive primary medical care services.

Mental Health Therapist

The Mental Health Therapist is a licensed clinician who provides individual, family and group mental health counseling.

Health Educator

The Health Educator provides reproductive and sexual health education and resources to students and families.

Dentist

The Dentist is a licensed dental provider who provides comprehensive dental care through oral health exams, cleanings, and treatment using portable dental equipment.

Dental Assistant

The Dental Assistant prepares patients for dental treatment and supports the dentist during the dental exam and treatment.
